      - All except for Communication were approved previously
    - Residential: Biology, Business, Chemistry, Communication, CJ, EC Teacher Licensure, El. Ed. English, Exercise Science, Fine Arts, History, Math, Physics, Psychology, Secondary Ed, Sociology, Theater.
      - All except for Biology and Exercise Science & Kinesiology were approved previously
    - Signatures were received for approved online transfer majors; still waiting for signatures for residential transfer majors
  - For approval at this meeting:
    - From email communication with registrar:
      - Course equivalencies for cc courses in discipline frameworks have been added
      - The courses selected for each of the programs are designed to cover the CLOs of the course and be equivalencies for the pathway courses
      - There will be zero repeat of any courses for students
