*The federal reimbursement rate for School Food Authorities which served 60% or more of free and reduced price lunches during the 2008-2010 school year will be increased by two cents for National School Lunch Program participation.

School Food Authorities which served 40% or more free and reduced price lunches during the 2007-2008 school year are eligible for severe need breakfast reimbursement which is:

Free Breakfasts	\$ 1.76
Reduced Price Breakfasts	\$ 1.46

**The State rate will be adjusted downward in the spring based on the number of meals served and available funding. There will be no State reimbursement in May and June, 2011.
