Data Sources

- Special education and general education data from Certified Enrollment File (Fall SRI – Student Reporting in Iowa)
- Discipline data from Spring SRI – Student Reporting in Iowa
- Redaction rule of less than 10 students on an IEP in a race or ethnicity group applied to data presented in all tables
- When a district has fewer than 10 students on an IEP in the comparison group, the state rate is used for comparison

Discipline - a district must have a total of ten or more students with IEPs with in- school and/or out-of-school removals totaling greater than 10 days and a risk ratio greater than or equal to 3.50 for the current school year. <u>These data are presented on a separate tab as they are for all students regardless of race/ethnicity.</u>		Years of Data Considered
B4A	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, cumulative in and out-of-school suspensions and expulsions of more than 10 days.	1
Discipline - a district must have a total of ten or more students with IEPs of the race/ethnicity in question for the removal type in question and a risk ratio greater than or equal to 3.50 for any racial/ethnic category for the current year for in- school, out-of-school or cumulative removals totaling greater than 10 days. All other removal categories require a risk ratio of greater than 3.5 for three consecutive years.		Years of Data Considered
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, out-of-school suspensions and expulsions of 10 days or fewer by race/ethnicity.	3
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, out-of-school suspensions and expulsions of more than 10 days by race/ethnicity.	1
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, in-school suspensions of 10 days or fewer by race/ethnicity.	3
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, in-school suspensions of more than 10 days by race/ethnicity.	1
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, disciplinary removals in total, including in-school and out-of-school suspensions, expulsions, removals by school personnel to an interim alternative education setting, and removals by a hearing officer by race/ethnicity.	3
B4B	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, cumulative in and out-of-school suspensions and expulsions of more than 10 days by race/ethnicity.	1
Identification - a district must have a total of ten or more students enrolled with IEPs from the race/ethnicity in question and a risk ratio greater than or equal to 3.50 for any racial/ethnic category for the current year.		Years of Data Considered
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21, identification by race/ethnicity.	1
B9	- for children with disabilities ages 6 through 21, identification by race/ethnicity.	1
Placement - a district must have a total of ten or more students with IEPs of the race/ethnicity in question for the placement type in question and a risk ratio greater than or equal to 3.50 for any racial/ethnic category for three consecutive years.		Years of Data Considered
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 6 through 21, inside a regular class less than 40 percent of the day by race/ethnicity.	3
CEIS	- for children with disabilities ages 6 through 21, inside separate schools and residential facilities, not including homebound or hospital settings, correctional facilities, or private schools by race/ethnicity.	3
