There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and each succeeding fiscal year, the sum of twelve million six hundred six thousand one hundred ninety-six dollars. The moneys shall be allocated as follows:</p> <p>b. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and for each succeeding fiscal year, eight million five hundred thirty-six thousand seven hundred forty dollars of the funds appropriated shall be allocated to the child development coordinating council established in chapter 256A for the purposes set out in subsection 2 of this section and section 256A.3.</p> <p>2. a. Funds allocated under subsection 1, paragraph "b", shall be used by the child development coordinating council for the following:</p> <p>(1) To continue funding for programs previously funded by grants awarded under section 256A.3 and to provide additional grants under section 256A.3. The council shall seek to provide grants on the basis of the location within the state of children meeting at-risk definitions.</p> <p>(b) To provide grants to provide educational support services to parents of at-risk children age birth through three years.</p> <p>Handout: Information will be viewable via screen share.</p>
