Dear Superintendent Brosamie:

Thank you for your request for permission to provide primarily remote or continuous learning for the Boyer Valley Community School District, dated January 21, 2021.

The Iowa Department of Education granted your district's request for primarily remote learning a single school building. You have since expanded your request for the entire district. The requested dates are the same dates, and the public health concerns are identical.

After consultation with the Iowa Department of Public Health and considering the facts as a whole, the Department GRANTS your AMENDED request to provide primarily remote or continuous learning beginning January 20, 2021, for the entire district.

Primarily remote or continuous learning may be provided for up to 14 calendar days between January 20, 2021 and February 3, 2021. You may stop providing primarily remote or continuous learning at any time during this period.

The Department expects in-person extracurricular activities to cease during the entire time period that students are receiving 100% remote learning within the approved 14 calendar day window. This approval is conditioned upon satisfying that expectation. Extracurricular activities may continue on an online or virtual basis.
