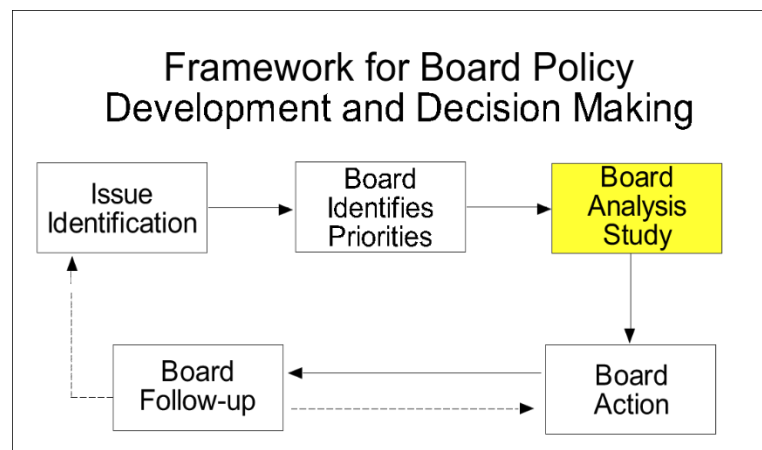

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board hear and discuss this information.

Background: The Elementary and Secondary Education Act, recently reauthorized as the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), is one of America's most important federal education laws. It provides for a number of national programs that support "leveling the playing field" for disadvantaged children in obtaining a high-quality education. This presentation will update the State Board on the statewide rollout of Iowa's new school accountability system under ESSA.
