



Iowa Online Drinking Driver Education Information

Iowa law requires that an individual, found to have been operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated, complete a drinking driver program. Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds has provided a temporary suspension of Iowa Administrative Code 281—21.31(3)(b) which dictates that this course be delivered in person. Therefore, until rescinded, individuals that are required to complete a drinking driver course for the **state of Iowa** may complete the online OWI education course made available through the Iowa Department of Education.

The online course that Iowa is using for the drinking driver education course is called MyPrime. This course was developed by the Prevention Institute and is closely aligned with the Prime for Life curriculum that Iowa currently utilizes in their in-person classes.

Access to MyPrime will ONLY be available until the state of Iowa deems it appropriate to hold in-person classes again.
