



## Iowa CLNA Regional Worksheet for School District, Consortia or Community College 2021

The following guidance is provided by the Bureau of Career and Technical Education to complete the [local CLNA Regional Worksheet for School District, Consortia or Community College](#).

1. Obtain the Iowa CLNA Regional Worksheet for your Regional Planning Partnership (RPP) from your RPP Coordinator.
2. Review the regional priorities with all CTE educators and stakeholders in your school district, consortium or community college.
  - a. These priorities are from the CLNA Regional Phase meetings held across the state. The priorities were brought forth from the local CLNA documents completed in 2019-2020.
  - b. The priorities listed on the CLNA Regional Worksheet are for the next two years (2021-2022 to 2022-2023).
3. Complete the CLNA Regional Worksheet for School District, Consortia or Community College.
  - a. Select one to three of the regional priorities that your school district, consortium, or community college will hyper-focus on for the next two years.
    - i. School districts within a consortium can select individual district priorities to work toward. Note this in the Strategies section (See Priority 2 example [here](#)).
  - b. Describe the strategies that will be used to reach the priority.
    - i. The strategies used can mimic the Regional Worksheet and/or include local strategies.
  - c. Select the priority level: high, medium, low.
  - d. Describe the funds that will be used, if any, to work toward this priority.
    - i. Possible funding streams include Perkins funds, RPP funds, Community College funds (Under Perkins V, each college is required to spend 5% of its allocation on secondary partnerships, Iowa State Plan pg. 57), Local School District funds, other grants funds, etc.
  - e. Fill out the signature sheet.
4. Save as a PDF.
5. Upload into the Perkins V application when prompted.
